
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Joy of Giving

"We make a living by what we get but we make a life by what we give".

How beautifully this quote of Winston Churchill describes the significance of altruism in making our life meaningful. Athaveda exhorts man to take to philanthropy- 'Earn with hundreds of hands and distribute with thousands. However in today's materialistic world, marred by greed and corruption, charity is in short supply as there is no end to our desires or aspirations...

Most of us do charity or give donations not out of any feeling. For many charity means dumping their discarded wares. Some of us donate gold and cash generously to shrines to wash our sins and seek salvation. Many of us take to philanthropy out of pride of being virtuous, even going to the extent of publicising it. Bhagvad Gita describes 'giving' in the expectation of receiving some favour or getting something as 'selfish giving'.

'Giving' symbolises selflessness while 'expecting' is an expression of selfishness. But sadly in this materialistic society, everyone expects to receive without giving, little realizing that expectation bring with it dissatisfaction and distress. On the other hand when one gives, there is a feeling of contentment.

The idea of giving or sharing has been propagated by gurus, prophets and seers since ages and nurtured through Sangat (holy assembly) and Langar (community kitchen). Guru Nanak emphasised on 'Vand Chakko' (sharing). Sikh gurus promoted the concept of 'Dasvand'- donating one tenth of one's earnings. In Guru Nanak's words, "Ghali khai kichhu dei, Nanak rahu pachhanahi sei' (He alone knoweth the way who eats out of what he earneth by his honest

labour and yet shareth part of it with them But sadly we have today become so selfish that we have conveniently forgotten about caring and sharing. And due to this selfishness we are witnessing growing disparity in the society. That's why Babaji has been emphasising on sharing of resources for inclusive development of society and nation as a whole with the realization that physical and material assets belong to God and we are only the trustees.

In today's world when there is a mad race to acquire luxuries of life, it is not easy to share one's material possessions. This is possible only if one attains God knowledge and develops the understanding that all things of the world- animate and inanimate are not ours. We have the right to use and enjoy them but not the right to possess them .Bhagvad Gita precisely teaches us this. Even Babaji says that we are mere trustees of physical, mental and material possessions which God has bestowed on us. And once that realization dawns on us, we come out of our false identity and give up possessiveness-the cause of our misery.

Babaji says that when God knowledge reveals the existence of the 'one' in diversity of this world, the walls of 'otherness' collapse and feeling of 'oneness'-embracing fellow humans gets strengthened. "SANT NIRANKARI MISSION in United Nations Commission on the status of women conducted from March 4th March 15th in New York, USA".

Appreciating the distinguished sociowelfare activities of the Sant Nirankari Mandal, Special Consultative Status was granted by the United Nations in July 2012 which facilitates, the Mandal to participate intimately in the work of U.N. in particular ECOSOC and its subsidiaries to achieve Millennium Development Goals for upliftment of the world community.

Participation:

Representatives of Member States, UN entities, and ECOSOC-accredited non-governmental organizations (NGOs) from all regions of the world attended the session.

193 countries were represented at the UN sessions by their organizations (NGO), Government ministers, dignitaries, ambassadors, and students. Panelists were from WHO, UNICEF, UNESCO, FOKUS, UNECE, and other coalition groups. Dr. Iqbaljit S.Rai,



President, SNM, USA, Mrs. Harlivleen Bajwa, Member I/c, Social Welfare, USA and Rev. Shashi (Shabnam) Madhok, Delegate, (USA). from Sant Nirankari Mission participated in the aforesaid Commission attending 3-4 sessions every day in addition to net-working with others.

Common Theme of the Conference:

"How to raise the core values of humanity to love and respect each other irrespective of culture, cast, gender, age and nationality and to identify the cause for inequality, violence, child marriages, human trafficking and to achieve spiritual growths in the society?



Contributions by SNM Delegates:

Most of the work focused on policies, to promote education, provide support & resources, and enforce laws. In order to bring reform at the family level, faith based organizations like Sant Nirankari Mission play an integral role in addressing the issues of love, respect for each others. This was the thought shared by Shashi Madhok and SNM delegates at multiple sessions. Providing further insight into SNM's work, delegates explained that Nirankari Mission, a Faith based worldwide organization, actively involved in changing the attitude and behaviors of human beings. It brings people together irrespective of age, culture, cast, religion, gender and nationality. It focuses on the core values of humanity. Family is the core foundation of society. The social reform as outlined in the UN can be supported by the faith based organizations was mentioned again and again by Dr. labaljit Rai, Mrs. Harlivleen Bajwa and Shashi Madhok during various sessions.

The Mandal feels that laws, regulations and enactments only impose external conditions on the people but do not bring about changes in the general outlook of individuals which is necessary for internal reform. This reform can be

introduced to the conscience of individuals by awakening one about the universal oneness and brotherhood. This changed behavior results in creating the feelings of patience, love, tolerance, serenity and general well being of one and all. There remains only a human being, not a

man or a woman. This is that fundamental truth around which the Sant Nirankari Mandal has knit its world of love, compassion, peace, tolerance and above all equality.

The Nirankari Mission also supports the society and social structure by providing resources through Educational institutions, Medical services, Shelters, mass blood donation camps, disaster relief funds, was also stated at the various panel discussions question answer sessions by Mrs. Harlivleen Baiwa. Dr. Rai's shared following thoughts during his interactions with panel members during various sessions :

For democratic values to prevail the world over, it is essential that woman should be freed from discrimination. Firstly, she should believe in equality, which is possible by getting educated. In the first instance, it is education that enables a woman to feel herself equal to a man and that in turn motivates him to accept her being equal. Some reactionary forces are trying to suppress the desires of girls to pursue education but that should never discourage girls from pursuing education. Shining example in front of us is that of a brave little Pakistani girl Malala who has shown tremendous courage and resolve inspite

of arave threat to her life from fanatic forces and given a message to all those girls who feel they have same right to education as boys.

It should also be noted that economic development alone does not exclusively provide base for change in the situation. To, illustrate, the example of a State in North West India is

worth quoting. The economic development which this State has seen during the last 40 years has not brought about any radical change in the status of women there. On the other hand, example of a southern state in India is cited to prove that the economic development affects the condition of women only if it is supplemented by the level of literacy and education. In other words economic growth as well as literacy go hand in hand for the development of human race. Sant Nirankari Mandal has gone one step further. It gives importance to spiritual education. Worldly education



augmented by spiritual education has helped in bringing transformation among the masses. Self-awakening is the bedrock that provides strength to the societal and cultural norms. Keeping track of mainstream of spirituality, the Sant Nirankari Mandal believes and preaches that same divine light dwells in every human being, male and female all human beings are brothers and sisters comprising one global family where everyone shuns the feelings of hatred, superiority, vengeance and lust on discovering that same string of soul

passes through all humans.



BIVALENCE

Ambivalence is a state of mind when irreconcilable mixed thoughts operate simultaneously. This is not an isolated feeling. In a smaller or greater magnitude it happens with every body, at every step and in every walk of life. Whenever a man is haunted by a state of ambivalence, he cudgels his brain, reads certain relevant books, recollects some precendental events and consults specialists of the line to find out the way he should move.

Man has always been facing an enigma of religion. Strictly speaking he talks much more about religion than actually he loves it. To quote Vatican Council II "Man looks to various religions for answers to those

profound mysteries of the human conditions which today, even as in olden times, deeply stir the human heart: What is man? What is the meaning and purpose of our life? What is goodness and what is sin? What gives rise to our sorrows and to what

to true happiness? What is the truth about death, judgment and retribution beyond the grave? What

purpose? Where lies the path

finally is that ultimate and unutterable mystery which engulfs our being and whence we take our rise and whither our journey leads us?"

With these queries in mind the ambivalent man reads out scriptures and goes to the altars. He also discusses the subject with his colleagues and so-called saints. But the more he goes ahead with the search, the more he is faced with intricate and vexed problems. A state of ambivalence opens a front against him. This is attributed to his wrong approach to religion.

It is common to adhere to the belief that

God made man after His own image and likeness. But practically, the process is reverse. It is man who fashions God after his own liking. It is perhaps in this context that once a saints remarked, "There are plenty of people who are dead without knowing God." 'Yes' said another saint, "Only they have not the sense to lie down." Modern man is dead without knowing God Obviously, he is not following the right path, but when some enquiry is made about his mode of worship, he proudly argues "As 'all roads lead to Rome,' all modes of God-worship lead to God realization". The question is how far it is justifiable to compare God with Rome? Rome is a fixed place for which different ways (roads) can be followed to reach there. But God is not fixed in some isolated place.

It is Omnipresent and there hardly arises any question of adopting different ways or modes of

worship to reach Him and realize Him.

Human life considered a unique blessing being the crown creation of universe. This uniqueness, however, lies not merely in the birth as a human being, but in the achievement of

purpose for which it is actually meant. As the Divine Truth is eternal, so is the True Master (Satguru) to bless the seekers with the Divine Knowledge, "Prophet is said to be the oldest and the newest on earth, like the day and night which have followed each other down the ages, and are still ever new." (Atharva Veda 10:8:23). Going by all the acknowledged scriptures, there is one and only one method for realization of God and that is through the grace of the contemporary Satguru, "Guru Bin Bhavnidhi Tarai Na Koi" and "I am the way, the Truth, the life, None can cometh unto the Father but by me."

The generally repeated question, "Can

Formless God be seen?" is a patent negation of the very experience and teachings of the True Masters who have said in no uncertain terms that God can be seen and realized. Human life is primarily meant to realize God and, on request, Nirankari Baba or his anointed saint shares the knowledge with the seeker in one sitting without any time-lag.

There are still some persons who do believe in the necessity of Guru (True Master) but they venture to find the Guru with strange tests. They veil over the real chapter, as if hypnotized, and look out for a Guru who can meet with their terrestrial gains. Such persons are far away from the real track. When such persons see gain elsewhere, they tilt the balance.

The acid-test of a True Master is one and only one. He knows God himself, and can enlighten others in no time. In this context, I am reminded of an incident told by respected D.S. Shaua Ji, Parmukh, Chandigarh and I feel inspired to quote it here. There was some Major in the Army. He was a follower of Lord Krishna and had faith in the Bhagwat Gita. He was persuaded by a Nirankari saint Brigadier to get enlightenment, as per Gita, from the living Prophet Baba Gurubachan Singh Ji Maharaj. The Major accompanied by his wife, visited the Nirankari Baba in Mussoorie. The couple took the spiritual vision (Gyan) also. While returning, his jeep went out of order and his wife atonce broke out, "Lo, Major Sahib, you have your faith in Gita shaken and here you face the music now. What has it availed you to join this Nirankari Mission?" The state of ambivalence prevailed upon the Major. On the one hand, the words of his wife were resounding in his ears and on the other hand he glanced his eyes across the sky and the knowledge of Formless Omnipresent God went deep down his very nerves. With heart within and God all around, the Major rushed

to the Nirankari Baba once again and laid open before him the mystery of his jeepfailure. Baba Ji heard the Major and replied, "Dear saint, the incident of your jeep-failure is a practical test of your patience and steadfastness over Truth, but is has no relevancy with the realization of God. It is just a matter of co-incidence. Supposing, you had not attended the Nirankari Sangat and had not taken the gyan and your jeep had failed, would you have attributed the failure to your not taking the gyan? No, that is quite wrong. The Guru gives spiritual outlook which accrues love for God and eye for worldly attainments. The moment you try to guide your life by God's Will, you have religion. With such an out-look the life becomes cozy and smugy.

The Major then concluded that God is not an alibi as many so called religious people imagine. He is not an insurance against possible failures and it is this false conception of God that irks modern man. It is essentially a way of life. It is a vision.

Valerian Cardinal Grecias hits the nail on the head when he says, "Modern man wants a new religion to suit the new spirit of the agea religion as fresh and brilliant as the age in which we live, with its new hopes, new dreams and new vision. The new religion must be above all social bindings; it must devote itself to the practical needs of the day." Sant Nirankari Mission has achieved this objective veiling over ritualism different for different religions and introducing face to face God, the Corner stone of all religions.

With all the plans and grand schemes for development there is at the bottom an emptiness and yearning for God. India, nay, every country needs more of God than of gold. It is an emptiness that sustains man's life. It relieves us of the tension which tears our hearts. Great thinker Augustine of Hippo wrote, "Restless are our souls until they rest in Thee, my God".

The 10 km Run was flagged off by His

You have all come to attend this 2-day Regional Sant Samagam of Uttar Pradesh. Filled with spiritual reverence and devotion, you have arrived here from various places to join the welfare drive for the whole mankind. Saints and sages, gurus and prophets have always been working for the beneficence of mankind.



to redeem it by becoming the medium of saving it from the darkness of ignorance. Today also, you have all come here, creating an enriching atmosphere, to contribute for the welfare of the world, which is the utmost requirement at present. We are well aware of the present scenario in the world. We find that the existing atmosphere, not only in our homes, localities cities, states and nation, but in the whole world, is because of man's bad deeds. The prevailing venomous and suffocating atmosphere is due to man's ignorance, whereas the atmosphere



created by you, is pleasing and peaceful. This shows as to what extent we can enrich this human garden that is needed by the whole world. Such contributions are visible here.

I have been getting opportunities to visit various places where different languages are spoken. A few days after the Annual Samagam in Delhi and, Bhakti-Parv-Samagam in mid-December; I got a chance to visit same European countries. All those countries, be it Italy, Spain, England, Sweden, Austria or Germany, have their

own distinct language. Soon after returning from there, a 3-day Sant Samagam of Maharashtra was held in Mumbai, where the main language was Marathi. And in the same way, on March 2 & 3, the Regional Samagam of 'Bihar-Jharkhand' was organized in Patna after which I got a chance to visit many places in neighbouring Nepal. And from there we reached Lucknow directly. Here also, saints and 'Mahapurshas' are giving the same message to the world, emphasizing the most significant aspect of life, perceiving which all can attain peace and solace.

While in Nepal, I met many people, who are also contributing to the political sphere there. They also talked about the chaos and commotion prevalent there. There was complete shut down for 2-3 days but congregation went on as usual. It is not just Nepal or India, everywhere the atmosphere is being polluted by man's selfishness, avarice, narrow-mindedness and ego. These are the causes, which make man harm mankind and pollute the atmosphere. Devotees, 'Mahapurshas', saints, gurus sages and prophets have been giving the same message to man asking him to pay attention to the direction to which he is moving. What direction are you taking? Whom are you following? What path are you treading? What is your approach? What are your tendencies? If you ponder over it, you will find that you don't have a good approach, it rather tends to be harmful. Mahapurshas and saint are cautioning man that he should well in time analyse the path he is following, whether it leads to sublime heights or downfall. Today, man is following the path that leads to his downfall. He is causing the downfall of other as well because of his ignorance. Whenever man remains ignorant and follows the path contrary to enlightenment,

be it in any era of century, man's negative tendencies become the cause to harm mankind all-around. It is not the matter of any one particular era; darkness and light, morning and night (enlightenment and ignorance) have been there in all ages, be it Satyug, Treta Yug, Dwapar Yug or Kaliyug.

Darkness and light (night and morning) have always existed according to the laws of Nature. Similarly, there have been human tendencies of ignorance and enlightenment. In Satyug, Harinakashyap was haughty and egoistic, possessing demon-

like tendencies, while his son, 'Bhakt' Prahalad emulated light, that is devotion, love, compassion and mercy. In Treta, Dwapar and Kaliyug, there existed darkness in the form of Ravana, Kansa and Duryodhna and the likes of many more. On the other hand, there had been embodiments of 'light' like Jesus Christ, Prophet Mohammad, Guru Nanak Dev, Guru Gobind Singh, Saint Kabir, Ravidas, Mirabai, Tukaram, Namdev or Vaitanna in various eras. So, while on the one hand, such personi-

fications of light providing enlightenment existed in some era, there also simultaneously existed others, who personified cruelty and who tormented the saints, considering that they had strayed from the path. Hence, both these forms of humans have been existing simultaneously in any era. So, man! You better come to your senses in time and follow the direction leading to your redemption which has been shown by the saints, prophets and gurus. Treading this path, you will attain your destination (salvation) and become a true human being. Otherwise, you can not become even an ordinary human being.

If darkness of ignorance still exists in your life and if you continue to be ignorant, deprived of awareness, you will be called a demon in future also, as you have been called so, earlier. O' man, if you tread the right path, the flame of awareness will be lit;

get illuminated. If you imbibe the wisdom of saints, you will be deity instead of a human being. Just see earlier:

Inka marg aur hai, unka mar gaur!

That these paths are divergent. The path adopted by devotees is different from the one adopted by those who subscribe to gross living. The bearings of devotees is different from those susceptible to devilish inclination.

Both kinds of people comprise of the same five elements; their eating habits and way of dressing is the same. It is not like that the people possessing demon-like tendencies will be recognized as such from a distance as if they would be bearing horns or a tail. They are also in the form of human body but their aptitude is different. There is difference in the thinking, approach, feeling and

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behavior of both the kinds. One is contributing to the world in some useful way, while the others' contribution is contrary to that.

One is engaged in uprooting others, while the other is involved in saving and rehabilitating fellow humans. One is occupied in uplifting the fallen one, while the other is feeling happy by degrading others. One is applying balm, while the other is inflicting wounds. One is keeping religion alive, while the other is tarnishing the name of religion. How different they are from one another?

Mahapurshas and saints have given this message only: O'man, join the desirable league of saints because of which this human birth is considered as supreme. Otherwise there are eighty-four lacs species amongst which there is only one human species. It is very painful and shameful if you are not able to justify your birth as a human. There are many kinds of animals, birds and water-borne species, but human form is only one.

If even after having been born as a human, you are not able to become a human being in the true sense, then you are worse than animals because animals have not been given the capacity of rational approach. But you have been bestowed that capacity and if you do not apply it righteously, and rather misuse it, then it will cause harm to others. If somebody is empowered by wealth, he starts using it to the disadvantage of others; if somebody has the caliber to rule, he gets involved in exploiting others fully. If one has been entrusted with a sharp mind by God, he applies it to hatch conspiracies, causing immense damage. Thus, the faculties bestowed to man by God, are misused. Similarly, God has bestowed upon man the ability to think and reflect, but he is hardly making any good use of it, rather missing it. In this manner you will squander away your precious human birth like this and you will only be shamed here and thereafter. As mahapurshas have said : 'Papi karam kamavde, karde hai hai, Nanak jeon matthe madhania, teon matthe dharamrai'.

(The importance pertain to rituals and wail, Nanak says, they will suffer and get churned by Dhar mraj).



On the other hand, for those who get enlightened in time and follow the right path, it has been said

'Eithe Milan vadiaian, Dargah moksh dwaru.'

Such persons are held in high esteem in this world, and are redeemed thereafter. They don't have to feel ashamed in the court of God. And even Yamraaj can not strike at them now, as they have attained redemption.

Kabir jamm ka thenga bura hai Oh nahi sahiya jaye, ek jo sadhu mohe miliyo,

tinhi liya aanchal laye.

Otherwise, the blow of Yamraaj is very hand and man can not imagine, how painful it is! But when one is sheltered by a true saint, shown the right direction and is put on the right path with complete awareness, he reaches his destination (attains salvation). Thus, the saints made him aware of the Truth and awakened him from slumber. Mahapurshas and saints have given this message in every age and era so that man may attain such a sublime state of mind. All Vedas, scriptures and the

sayings of saints have persistently been exhorting men to follow this direction and today also the same thing is being reiterated. I have (always) been saying this again and again that why one needs to repeat a thing? If in first place attention is paid to what is being said, there will be no need to repeat it. Had people become aware of this truth in Satyug only, there would have been no need for the reincarnation of the saints. Then the following generations would have also been aware of the truth. One era comprises thousands of years; had people realized the truth, there would have been awareness everywhere. But, no it's not so. That is why, Lord Rama, Lord Krishna, Jesus Christ and all other gurus, saints and prophets at different times kept on making man realize the truth.

It is clear then that man does not understand easily. That is why the truth needs to be repeated again and again, continuing with the process to make man realize and shake him from deep slumber time and again. There are kinds of people who wake up at the first call, even if it is a feeble call. But then we find that sometimes

one of our family members has to be shaken out of sleep, once, twice or even thrice. Even then he doesn't get up, unless we shake him up fiercely. He will open his eyes for some time, mumble a little and then again go to sleep. The state of this world is similar. Man does not get awakened so easily. It is because of this reason that saints have to exert themselves knowing that the redemption of mankind lies in realising the truth. And that is why these lines are always repeated:

'Utth jag musafir, bhor bhai, ab rein kahaan jo sowat hai,

Jo jaagat hai, so paawat hai, jo sowat hai, so khowat hai.'

If people remain in slumber and do not awaken, they will lose in life. They will squander away the invaluable treasure of life itself. During this tour only, I mentioned it quite emphatically at one place that a few years back I happened to visit Denver in America which is situated on a 13000-14000 ft high mountain. We covered the steep slope

by train. When one goes to such height, one starts panting. Some people find it difficult to breathe like those suffering from Asthma. On reaching there, we found a big hall where one could get tea and coffee besides novelty items like picture post cards etc. When I glanced at a corner, I found an oxygen-cylinder with an attached machine where it was written that the cost of inhaling oxygen for one minute was two dollars. It came to my mind at once that we breathe

24,000 times in a day and If God also starts charging for that, where would it lead us? God is providing us with oxygen free of cost, whereas two dollars were being charged there for inhaling oxygen for one minute. I mean to say that our each breath is invaluable. But man is squandering away this treasure of life by slumbering in ignorance, while it should be fully utilized. If somebody has capital, he can multiply it with wisdom. He can build a business

empire; but if he fritters away his capital in gambling, luxuries of life and in gratifying his vices, he will become miserable. Similarly, God has given man this capital of life. He must make a good use of it and invest it in a manner so as to enrich his life here and hereafter. In such a way one should use this capital of life. Mahapurshas know that people will be squandering away this capital by remaining in slumber. That is why they have been

awakening man- 'Utth jag musafir bhor bhai, ab rain kahaan jo sowat hai.' (Get up man, night is over and it's dawn now.)

There is a golden opportunity in the form of a human body. Taking birth as human means 'dawn' has arrived. Why should one keep on slumbering when night is no more there. The time of remaining in darkness is over, as morning has arrived. But it will be very unfortunate if man still keeps on slumbering. That is why

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Mahapurshas have been making man aware so that somehow, he gets awakened. They kindle the feelings of truth, humanity, goodness and love because if man realizes the truth, he will get transformed and he will be able to contribute towards enrichment of this world as well. The words of mahapurshas have persistently been reflecting this message which is being reiterated today also: O'man! Just think and ponder over whether you have got awakened or are still in slumber. Have you become a human being in the true sense or not? Have you sought the 'nectar' or are still partaking poison.

Recently, during Nepal Samagam on the occasion of 'Shivratri' I said 'Hum uss daur mein jite hai Jahan Shiv se badh kar vish ko pite hain.

We live in an age where we partake poison instead of nectar. Meaning thereby that we don't lead a blissful life, because we don't imbibe virtues. We partake poison (evil), spoil others' lives by making their minds poisonous; thus turning them restless. This has been happening since ages, but 'mahapurshas' and saints are giving the message O'man! You should tread the path which leads to sublime status, blissful life and salvation. Mahapurshas and saints have always given this clarion call. Their words are not meant for listening reading and repeating only as pious statements; rather these are meant for imbibing. Man should rise above the misconception that reading out scriptures is a pious deed and ignoring these is a sin. If one takes holy dips, it does not mean that he is pious. Similarly if he does not take a holy dip, it does not mean that he is committing a sin. Man should not remain confined to rituals, but imbibe the sayings of 'mahapurshas', tread the path shown by them, attain 'Truth' and realize it to get redeemed. Man must attain the knowledge of all-pervading supreme God and enlighten mind and soul by keeping in communion with Him. As' mahapurshas' and Sufi-saints have said in Punjabi language

Gyan da diva bal hanere Teri labh jaye wast gavakhi.

That you should get enlightened to attain communion with God. You are deprived of the bliss of God-knowledge, because of darkness of ignorance. Like if a thing drops on the floor and gets lost in darkness, we use a torch, candle or a lantern to find it out. We are finally able to find it because of light. Similarly, 'mahapurshas' tells us to seek the enlightenment of God-knowledge to find the 'One' that seems to be lost, i.e. Super-



soul, the formless God.

We can not call God as missing in that sense as He is omni-present. How can the all-pervading God be lost? So, in that sense God is not amiss, but 'mahapurshas' and Sufi-saints imply something else. They mean to say that if you do not possess God, (have knowledge of God), He is as good as lost. If you find, Him, you get united with Him, otherwise you are separated from God. Moreover, it is not like that one can find God in forests or mountains. One will not be able to attain God by undertaking penance in

forests or taking holy-dips; He will be found through enlightenment. This line is also repeated again and again 'Je rab milda jungle vele, taan milda gawan, vachchian noo.' (If God could be found in forests, cows and calves would have found Him).

Then those species can be called blessed that take birth in forests only, because if God was to be found in forests, then animals are already there. And this will mean that there is no point in giving so much importance to human birth. And if man thinks that he will attain Godrealisation by taking holy dips, then also 'mahapurshas' have given a counterstatement 'Je rab milda nahatyan dhotyan, te milda dadduan machchian nu.'

That there are many species that live in water like frogs, fish, crocodiles etc. Then these should attain God-knowledge before man. Thus, 'mahapurshas' have made man face the truth in so many ways. The people who believe in penance and rituals as the means to realize the truth, react at such statements of 'mahapurshas'. They never tolerate the savings of saints like Kabir and Bulleshah, but truth will remain truth, as has been put out by devotees, saints, gurus and prophets that God can not be realized without enlightenment. So man should realise God and get redeemed in this life as upon attaining this realization, Illusions will get erased from the soul and

freedom from bondage and attain

redemption. He will

also be able to

lead his life

blissfully.

Today, 'maha-purshas' are giving the same inspiration. O'man! You should establish communion with God by realising the Truth, thereby making your life blissful. You must not fritter away this precious birth, but rather make optimum and righteous use of it. You should lead your life in an enriching manner, with love and good bahaviour. Make the righteous use of your body, wealth, intelligence and power so as to favour all. I extend my good wishes that man may make such attitude his way of life. Without taking more time I take leave of you, with these words. Today was the first day of Regional Sant Samagam of Uttar Pradesh, organized in Lucknow. You know that earlier it was to be held in Allahabad in the grounds where the Kumbh fair was held. The administration had given assurance to provide those grounds in time, but it seemed that it might not be possible because the preparations of such a vast Samagam needed time. That is why, the venue was shifted to Lucknow and the organizing body of the Mission, administration and other institutions made such good arrangement within a short period of time. Hence you are fully enjoying the bliss on the first day of the Samagam. And there is another day to go. May God bless that tomorrow also, we hear such sweet and beneficent words like today, so that all the time spent here becomes
