**3-DAY NIRANKARI SANT SAMAGAM BEGINS IN KHARGHAR AS

Navi Mumbai, January 27, 2017: The 50th Annual Nirankari Sant Samagam of Maharashtra began here in Kharghar today. Baba Ji left his physical form and merged into the eternal abode on May 13, 2016 while travelling by road, near Montreal in Canada.
