Mumbai, January 30, 2018 : On the concluding day of the 51st Annual Nirankari Sant Samagam of Maharashtra, Satguru Mata Savinder Hardev Ji Maharaj bestowed her blessings by praising the saints for their tremendous efforts that they made in order to spread the message of the Mission. Her Holiness exhorted all the devotees to continue to take the message of goodwill further not only by word but action also.

Her Holiness remembered Rev. Rishi Vyasdev Ji, who came to Mumbai from Haridwar with his spouse Mata Kanta Ji when Shahenshah Baba Avtar Singh Ji directed him. He was not even aware of Marathi language. Still with the help of other saints he started to spread the divine light here. Saints helped Rishi Ji in translation of Marathi into Hindi and his message was translated from Hindi into Marathi. Her Holiness said, it is the efforts of all those saints that today Mumbai Samagam has become so vast.

Her Holiness referred to NIS Samagam of U.K. Satguru Mata Ji narrated the incident of street play near Oxford University where students of multi-cultural nationalities come to study. Watching street play they asked emotionally, "Is it really that easy to feel and see God?".

Materialistic comforts are useful only if it is accompanied with strong foundation. The strong foundation can be laid down only by saints. Saints normally say we are giving our best to spread the message of the Mission but this is not sufficient. We have to succeed in doing whatever is possible to spread the Mission.

Her Holiness recalled when Baba Ji's words that to spread the Mission every saint will have to transform himself into a temple. He will have to imbibe teachings of saints, Gurus and prophets within oneself and will have to live upto it. This is not possible by one or two saints, all saints must act together.

Referring to the President of Sant Nirankari Mandal, Rev. JRD Satyarthi Ji who breathed his last in Delhi in the evening (Monday), Her Holiness said, he was a pillar of the Mission. We learnt a lot from him. We shall always remember his contribution to take the Mission forward.

The highlight of the concluding session of the Samagam was a multilingual poetic symposium on the theme – Nirakar Ka Le Aadhar, Jeevan Ho Gurmat Anusar. About 20 poets presented their poems in Marathi, Hindi, English, Bhojpuri, Punjabi and Rajasthani languages.

Addressing the concluding session Rev. Shambhunath Tiwari Ji, Chairman and Rev. Virendra Bamne Ji, Co-ordinator of the Samagam Committee thanked Satguru and the participating devotees for the smooth and successful Samagam. They said that there were several shortcomings but Satguru and Sadh Sangat have been gracious to ignore the same. They prayed to Satguru Mata Ji to bless all with a happy and prosperous life.
