

Blood Donation Drive at Tracy Bhawan Report

The Sant Nirankari Mission Universal Brotherhood is founded on the philosophy of unity and equality with the belief that all humans, regardless of caste, color, race, gender, or creed, are all one. His Holiness Baba Hardev Singh Ji Maharaj Ji established a blood donation program in honor of Baba Gurbachan Singh Ji who was martyred in 1986. The start of these blood donation programs serves as a active symbol of peace, tolerance, and non-violence. The Sant Nirankari Mission Universal Brotherhood believes that selfless service is the only way to serve other humans.

With the blessings of Nirankar and Satguru Mata Sudiksha ji, the Sant Nirankari Mission Universal Brotherhood partnered with American Red Cross and hosted a blood donation drive at Tracy Bhawan on April 28, 2019. Everyone from the American Red Cross employees, blood donors, and volunteers played an instrumental role in helping run the blood drive efficiently and with great success. All members exuded immense passion and willingness to go above and beyond to selflessly service humanity.



An official report from American Red Cross states that a total of 57 donors registered and only 10 were unable to donate. There were approximately 20 more saints who wanted to donate; however, they were unable to do so as registration had already closed. American Red Cross had a goal of collecting 42 units of blood and the Sant Nirankari Mission was able to accomplish 117% of that goal by collecting 49 units of blood. This translates to saving 147 lives. The Sant Nirankari Mission continues to be a leading supporter of blood donation organizations across the world while upholding Baba Hardev Singh Ji's vision of *human blood should flow in veins, and not in the drains*.
