As many of us are aware that homelessness is a growing issue in the Emerald city: Seattle, WA. There are over 10,000 men, women and children who are living on street, tents or in cars in King County: hungry and cold. The need is massive and is ongoing.

To help the cause, Sant Nirankari Mission, Seattle came together as a community in December 2019 to help their friends at one of the shelters located on the Eastside of Seattle. We initiated the contact with the shelter and worked to build our service to directly impact the crucial needs of the facilities. The Day Center serves families experiencing homelessness with access to showers, restrooms, laundry, snacks and dinner among many other services. Hot meals are the most desired as centers run out of resources to provide hot meals.
