Guru Puja Diwas – Tree Plantation Drive (2020)



On the occasion of Guru Puja Diwas, Sant Nirankari Mission Seattle conducted a tree plantation drive on 29th February 2020. Even though it was cool/rainy weather saints from age 4 to 60 years participated in this tree plantation drive. This drive was conducted with an organization called Mountains to Sound Greenway Trust, a non-profit organization that seeks to conserve and enhance the landscape from Seattle across the Cascade Mountains to Central Washington. The saints conducted this drive from 10 AM to 2 PM at the organization's tree nursery in Sammamish, Washington.

With the grace of HH Satguru Mata Sudiksha Ji, the Seattle branch was able to plant about 900 trees and weeded about 600 square feet of land at this event. The saints performed a variety of



tasks at this event. One group of saints was shoveling dirt into buckets and giving it to the saints who were potting the trees.

The saints who were potting the saplings put in extra care to make sure that the trees would be able to grow properly in the pot and would later be able to be planted in the wilderness. Then, another group of saints organized the potted plants into neat rows. In addition, the saints also helped weed the area around the nursery so that the potted trees would not have to compete with the weeds for natural resources.
