### Northwest Harvest Food Donation Event (April 2020)



With the grace of HH Satguru Mata Sudiksha Ji, 2<sup>nd</sup> time in a month Sant Nirankari Mission Seattle branch was able to donate food items to the non- profit organization Northwest Harvest in order to alleviate some of the hardships caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Northwest Harvest is a nonprofit food bank distributor operating statewide in Washington with a network of 375 food banks, meal programs and high-need schools. In order to support hungry people in the current crisis, the organization is distributing food to many of the food banks in the Seattle metropolitan area and are partnering with other agencies to meet the rapidly growing demand for emergency food in communities across Washington state.



On 10<sup>th</sup> April 2020, the Seattle saints started donating money for food drive and it continued for following 2 weeks.
