Sandwich Drive 2021



On the auspicious occasion of Guru Puja Diwas, Sant Nirankari Mission Seattle branch has conducted a Sandwich Drive with the Seattle's Union Gospel Mission. This organization is a nonprofit ministry that feeds and cares for homeless people throughout the greater Seattle area. They provide homeless people with warm places to sleep, hot showers, and home cooked meals. They also conduct special volunteering opportunities called Bring-A-Meal. In this event, volunteer can help cook or donate meals for the homeless at some of their centers. The Sant Nirankari Mission Seattle branch got the opportunity to make peanut butter-jelly sandwiches and donate them to one of their centers called Hope Place on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021.

With the grace of Her Holiness, Satguru Mata Sudiksha Ji, the SNM Seattle branch was able to make and donate 800 peanut butter-jelly sandwiches. Each family made 25 to 50 sandwiches. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all the saints made these sandwiches at their homes instead of making them together as a community while following the safety guidelines. The sandwiches were made using the ingredients specified by the Seattle's Union Gospel Mission. All the participating families delivered the sandwiches to their nearby designated drop off locations(one of the saint's residence) and later 4-5 saints went to donate the sandwiches to the Hope Place center. May Satguru Mata Ji bless us all with many more selfless service opportunities to serve the community in the future.
