The Closet's Store Manager, Patricia (Pat) Rhoads, has informed me that recently your organization delivered some 55 bags of clothes and shoes to our not-for-profit thrift shop in historic downtown Herndon. This is a remarkable donation that reflects the generosity and thoughtfulness of the members of your organization.

As you know, The Closet depends on donations from area residents for its inventory, which we then sell at affordable prices for the benefit of our low income clientele. The profits from these sales are distributed to local charities and to area high schools for college scholarships. Last year we distributed over \$130,000 in this manner. In addition, we distributed free of charge through our voucher program over \$100,000 worth of clothes and shoes to persons referred to us by local social service organizations. A similar amount was delivered to needy persons, free of charge, in western Virginia.

None of our charitable giving would be possible without the donations of area residents and organizations like Universal Brotherhood. The Closet is very grateful to your members and your organization for selecting The Closet as the recipient of your kindness and generosity. Thank you ever so much!
